

Virginia Beach Police Department to Implement Prescription Medication Take Back Program

Chief Jim Cervera and the Virginia Beach Police Department are implementing a prescription drug take back program, to better serve the community and provide a secure means for citizens to dispose of their unneeded prescriptions medications. Beginning Monday, June 22, 2015 the Virginia Beach Police Department will implement its initial pilot "take back" program at the First Precinct located at 2509 Princess Anne Road. A Prescription Drug Take Back container will be installed in the lobby of the First Precinct building and available seven days a week from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. All unneeded prescription medications will be turned in anonymously, with no paperwork required. After evaluating the pilot "take back" program at the First Precinct, the program will be extended to the Second, Third and Fourth Precincts providing this secure "take back" option for Virginia Beach residents at the closest police precinct to their residence. This new program will be completely voluntary and the Police Department will continue to use the same drug disposal process used for all recovered illegal drugs that are seized or recovered.
